Updates

You may recall that I mentioned in our last newsletter that I was seeking international consulting work in the energy business. God has blessed that effort already by providing a client who will use my skills on a West African natural gas project. God has also opened doors to at least two other opportunities, and if He sees fit to bring those to completion, I will indeed be very busy with work and travel. Isn't God good!!!!

God's opening the door for me to work as a consultant may well increase the need for volunteers to handle food procurement and/or delivery, so we ask that you continue to pray about whether God would have you become more actively involved in Grace of Giving's ministry effort.

Prayer Requests

It's amazing to see God's hand in things. I wasn't sure why I felt compelled to put the pictures of Bernie Segura and his ministry in last month's newsletter until a few days after the newsletter was published.

It was then that Bernie's wife, Gracie, telephoned me to report that criminal activity in the border region of Mexico where Bernie ministers is so bad that Bernie had been warned not to come with food deliveries. So, she asked me not to bring them any food in May. We're awaiting her guidance as to whether we should make a June delivery and praying that God will ease the circumstances so that Bernie can safely go to minister to and help feed his friends.

Please, please join us in praying for God's hand of protection to settle on Bernie's ministry and allow him to resume taking food to Mexico. Bernie serves in a very poor area along the border about 6 hours' drive west of Ojinaga, and the food assistance we send is put to very good use!

Financial Update

Since the beginning of 2008, we've limited our food delivery trips along the border to once per month, instead of once every three weeks as we did for 2007, while keeping the amount of food delivered each trip at the same level as 2007. Our goal was to reduce our overall food costs to a level more closely aligned with our contributions.

It seems that God has blessed this decision. Judge for yourself:


- Year-to-date contributions that were either designated for food or undesignated: \$29,480
- Year-to-date net food costs: \$29,744
- Percent coverage: 99.1%

Wow! You guys are good!

Unfortunately, food costs are continuing to increase. Rice has increased an astonishing 81% since we wrote to you about food cost inflation in March. Dry pinto beans have increased by as much as 40% in the same time period, although, in fairness, prices do vary a bit in different stores, and we try very hard to find the best price available.

Our request is simple. Please help us as much as you can, so that we can continue to make deliveries at our current levels. Please also pass our information along to friends that possibly don't know us, so they too can consider becoming a Grace of Giving supporter.

Finally, we all know about the pinch of current fuel costs. God hasn't told us to slow down what we're doing, so we just ask Him to continue to provide!!

Housing Projects Update

Our building plans for 2008 include, God willing:

one house in Monclova, Coahuila for the Benito Amaya family:

We are awaiting God's guidance as to when He wants us to build the Monclova house. We will continue to make this need known to our supporters, and we will be begin construction only when God blesses us with the necessary funds.

The Jimenez houses are planned for the period October 19th - 28th. It appears that we may have an "overcrowding" problem at Camp Getsemani similar to that we experienced last fall. We are currently investigating the possibility of (relatively) inexpensive motel accommodation in Del Rio, which will increase the trip expenses somewhat (but will also make evenings a bit more comfortable!). We will, God willing, be able to provide more concrete information on lodging and trip costs in our next newsletter.

In the meantime, please consider joining us on the trip to Jimenez in October and/or supporting these mission efforts financially. We need the money for the Jimenez houses in hand by September 1st to send it ahead for materials procurement, and we also need 50+ intrepid souls to volunteer to be building crews and to handle trip logistics (feeding the building crews is definitely a priority!). Your help will be a wonderful blessing to these families in need!
